

2019-2020 Activities

NH Jump\$tart was not immune to the disruption caused by Covid-19. The impact of the pandemic began just as the majority of our activities were to begin in March.

As a result, we were forced to cancel the remaining in-person classroom presentations of our **I Can Save!** program; the State Final of our **FinLit300** high school competition; the annual **Classroom Connections** teacher workshop; and our fund-raising **Golf Tournament**.

We do, however, have some metrics to report for the activities prior to March 2020:

- Over **500** students were reached at **11** schools with our **I Can Save** presentations.



- Over **250** students from **9** schools participated in the online portion of the **FinLit300** tournament with the teams from **Goffstown High School** and **Winnacunnet High School** finishing 1st and 2nd, respectively.

- **50** teachers registered to attend the May **Classroom Connections** workshop before it was cancelled.



- We released the **2019 Survey of New Hampshire High Schools** detailing that 10 high schools in the Granite State now require a standalone course in personal finance for graduation in their district.
- We unveiled a newly redesigned website during the summer.



We look forward to resuming all of these activities beginning again during the 2020-2021 academic year.
