NH Jump\$tart entered its next quarter century in 2026! We look forward to continuing our mission of youth financial literacy in New Hampshire!

And in this academic year, a ½ credit, standalone course in personal finance is now a state graduation requirement in New Hampshire! Here are the results of this year's activities:

We met with over **550** second grade students from **16** elementary schools with our [I Can Save](#) program which focuses on needs and wants with an emphasis on saving, spending, and sharing.



Almost **500** students from **14** schools participated in the online portion of the [FinLit300](#) tournament with the teams from **Bow High School** and **Trinity High School** finishing 1st and 2nd, respectively.

We were pleased to bring back our new program from NH Jump\$tart called [The Reality Check Tour](#). NH Jump\$tart volunteers visited with high school students to have a conversation about money management goals and realities.



85 teachers attended the May [Classroom Connections](#) workshop for a full day of presentations!

116 players participated in our annual charity golf tournament in August which successfully kicked off our fund-raising efforts for the upcoming year.
